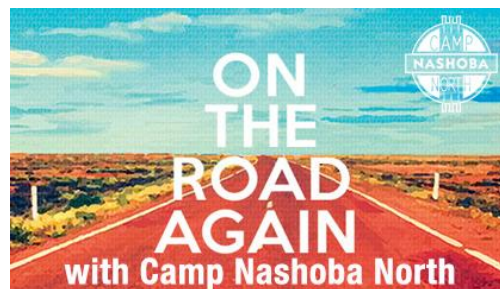

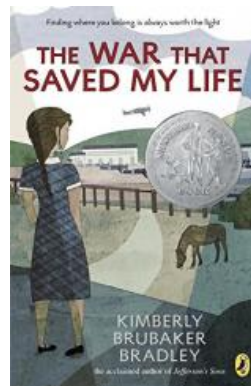


Nashoba Reads!!!
