The White House is considering cuts to the J-1 Visa program as a part of the implementation of the Buy American and Hire American Executive Order. In response to this threat, Nashoba North has joined with camps across the country in a legislative action campaign to help the White House and members of Congress understand the importance of the international cultural exchange and the value of the J-1 Camp Counselor and Summer Work Travel programs.
